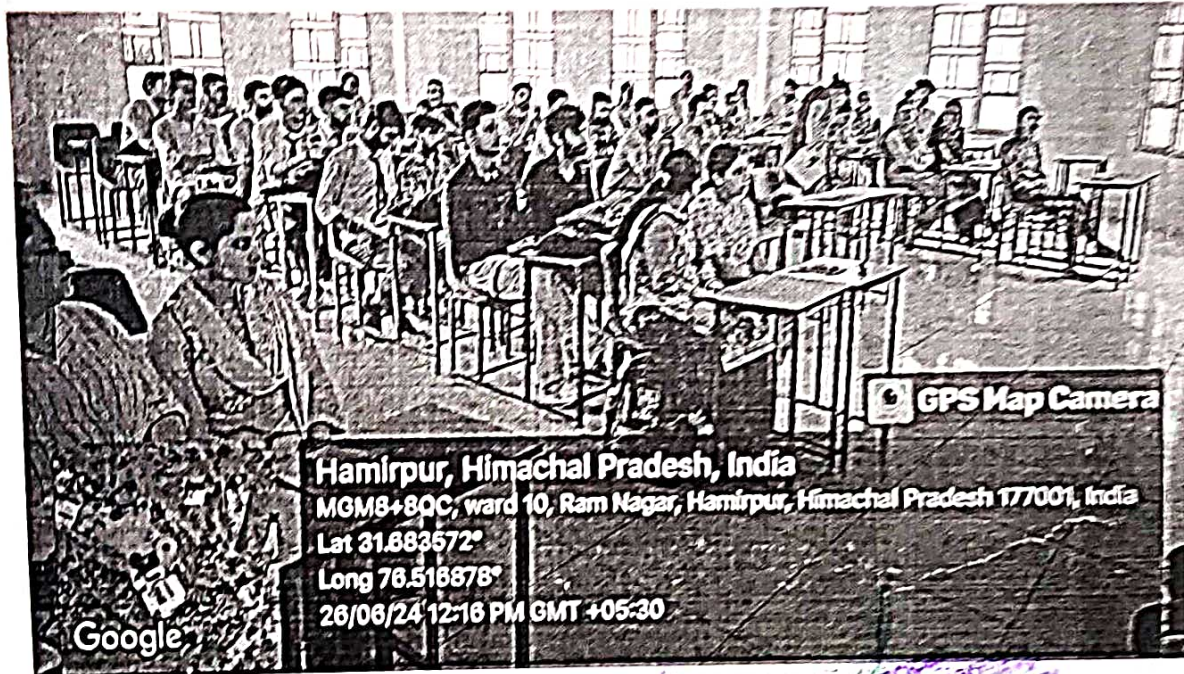
OUTCOME
