- Community members

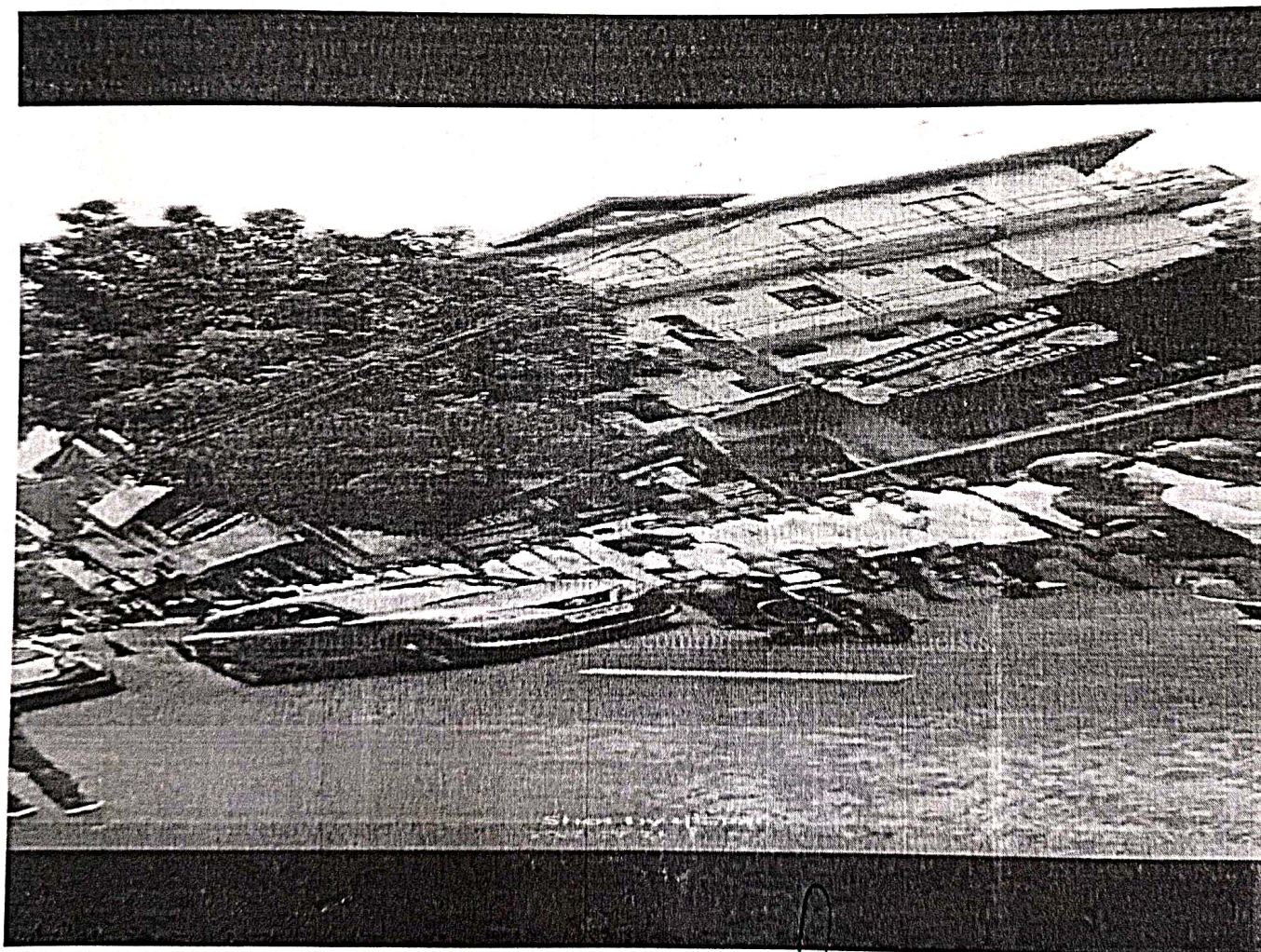
Activities:

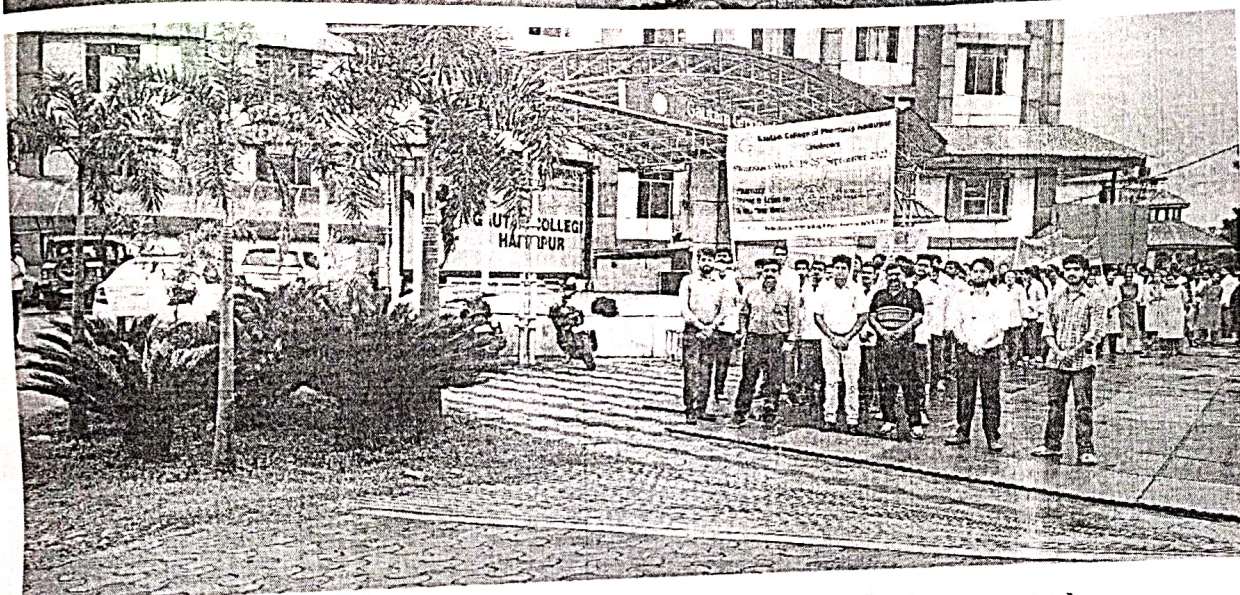
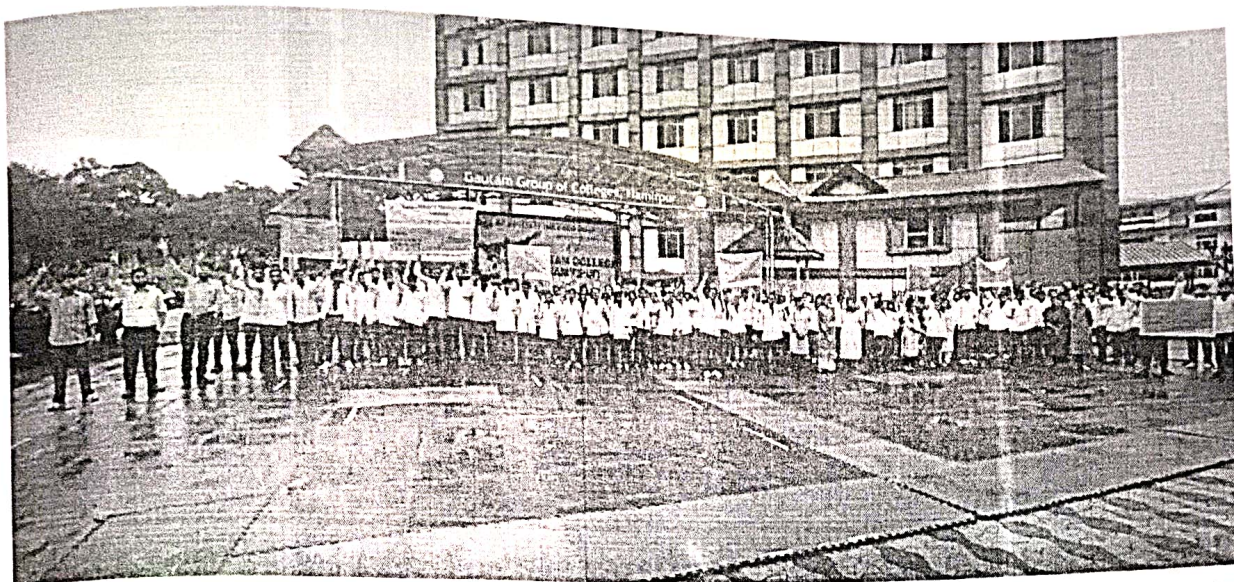

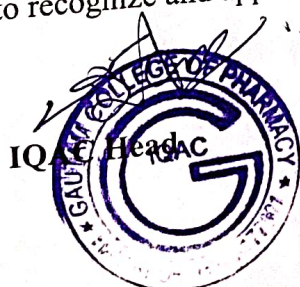
