
INTRODUCTION:




Gender Audit Steps:

 - Objective Identification: The Primary goal of the gender audit is to assess the gender balance and identify any gender-based inequalities within the college.
 - Work Plan Development: A detailed work plan was created, outlining the steps and methodologies to be used in the audit. Data collection and analysis were used as parameters to do the gender audit.
- 2. Data Collection:
 - Survey and Document Reviews: Comprehensive data was collected from various sources including surveys distributed to students, faculty and staff and a review of various policies, practices and procedure.
- 3. Analysis:
 - Data Examination: The collected data was meticulously analysed to uncover any gender-based inequalities. This analysis was focused on aspects such as gender representation in different departments, participation in extracurricular activities, and access to facilities and resources.
- 4. Reporting and Recommendations:
 - Findings and Suggestions: The results of the gender audit were compiled into a detailed report, highlighting key findings and areas needing improvement and recommendations were formulated to address the gender base inequalities.


Audit Details:

The gender audit covered various aspects of the institutions. Separate survey questionnaire was distributed to the faculty and the students to assess gender-based discrimination. In total 29 faculty members and 357 students were present in the college out of which 20 faculty and 219 students participated in their respective surveys.


Gender distribution of the faculty who attended the survey:




Gender distribution of the Students who attended the survey:


All the faculty members are given equal opportunity to engage in the academic research, submit project proposals, and implement projects. Research supervision is required for both the postgraduate and undergraduate students.

















Does the college primarily schedule its operational hours during the day, avoiding early morning or late evening classes?
