
### OUTCOME


### Placement percentage of students




Inaugural Session: The lecture commenced with a welcome address by the principal of Gautam College of Pharmacy, who emphasized the Intellectual Property Rights.


Q&A Session: following the lecture and interactive question and answer session was held, where participants had the opportunity to engage directly with Dr. Neha Goyal.
