An interactive session was held where participants could ask questions and discuss their concerns with the experts.


The session was aimed at clarifying doubts and dispelling myths related to TB.

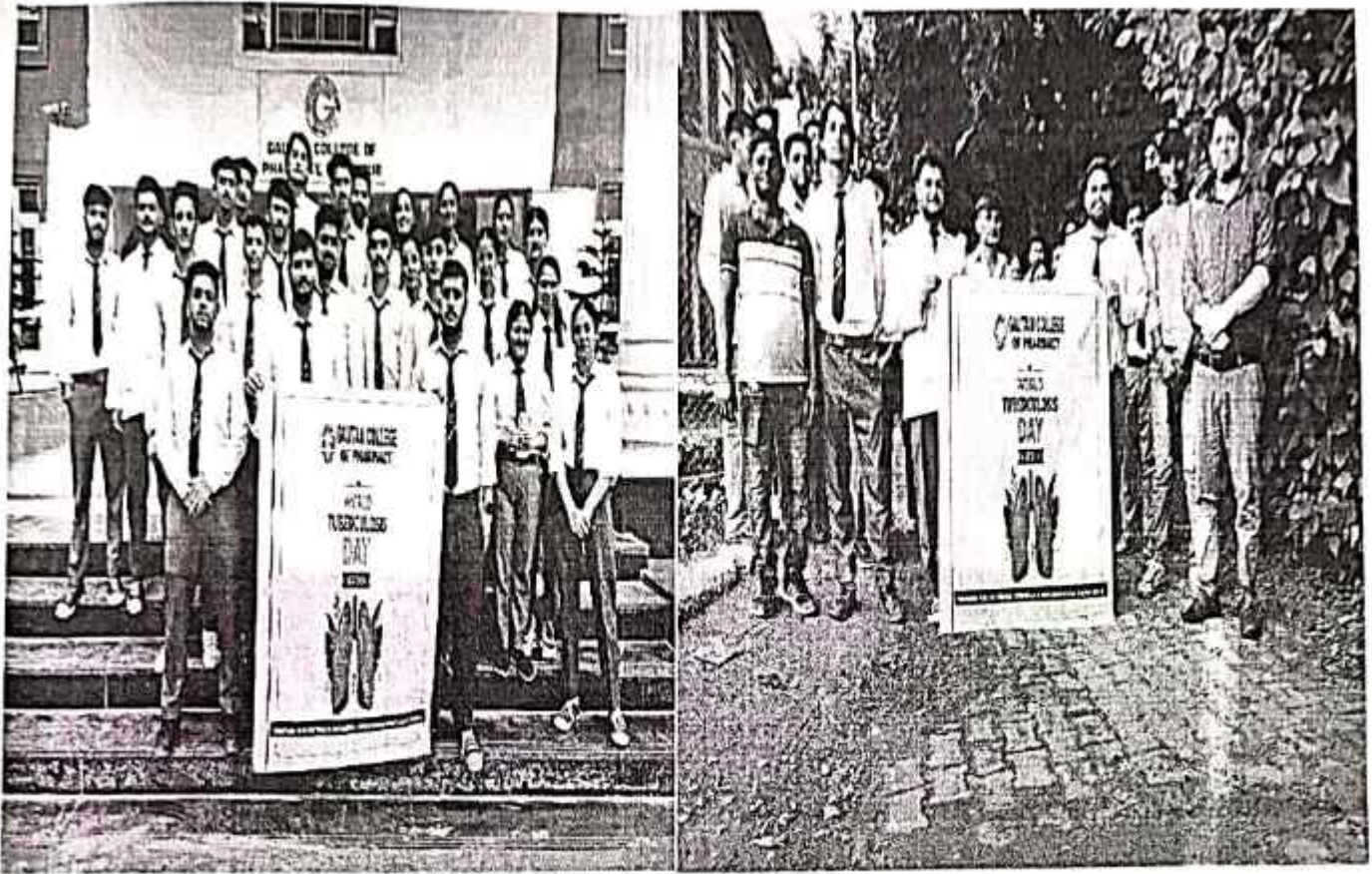
Rally and Street Play:


OBJECTIVE

Activities Organized


To mark this momentous occasion, three major activities were organized:



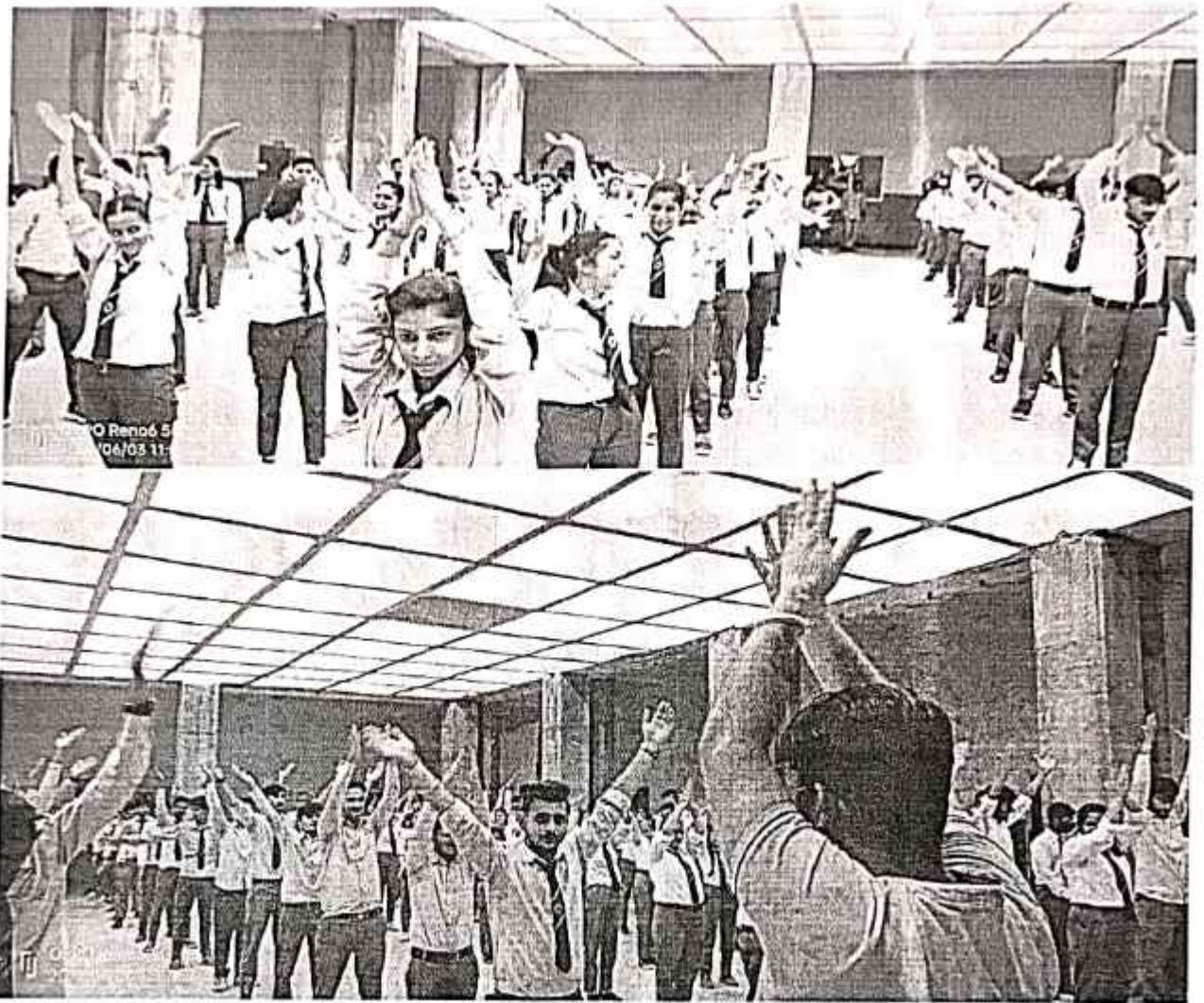

- Community members

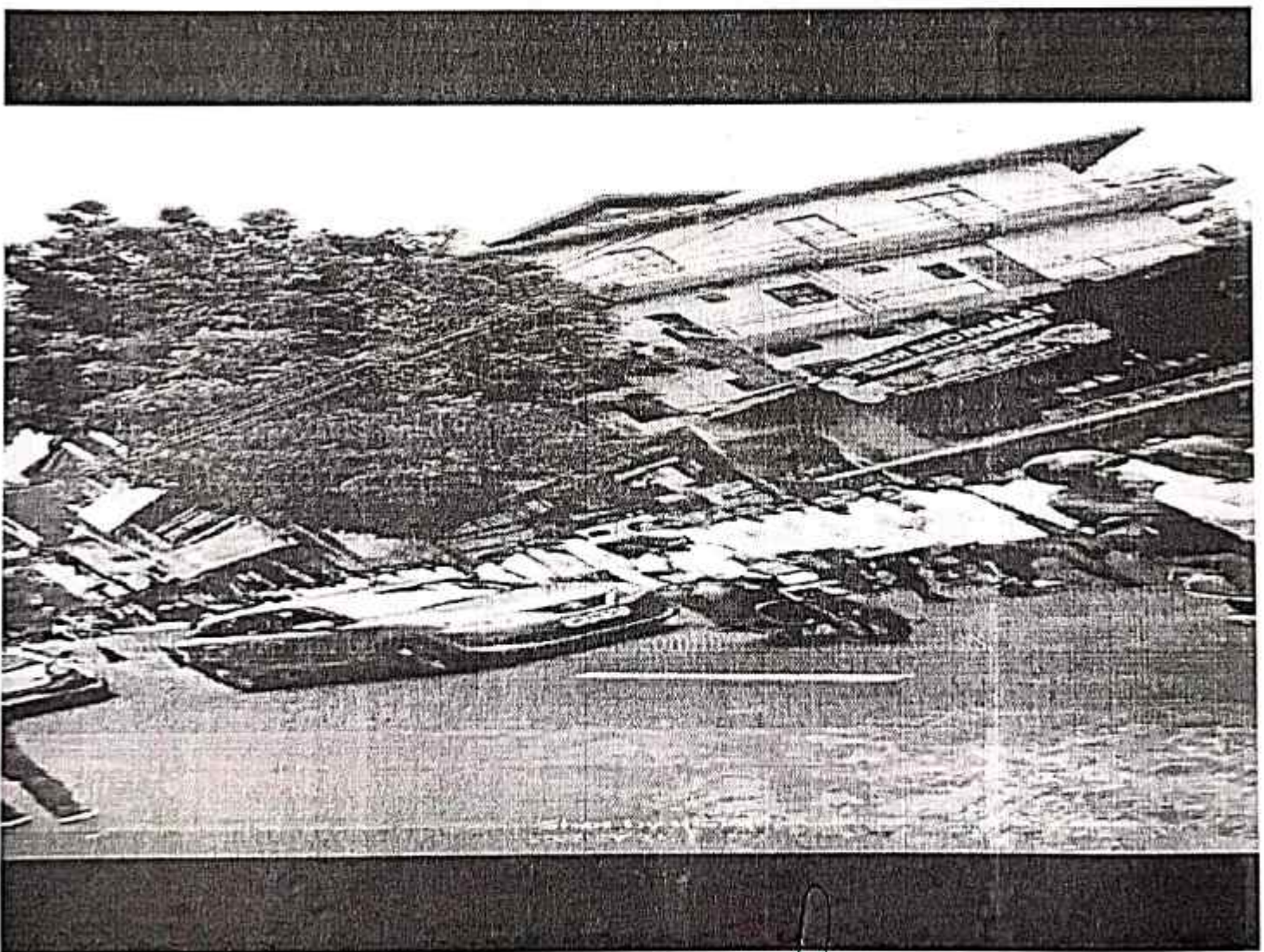
Activities:

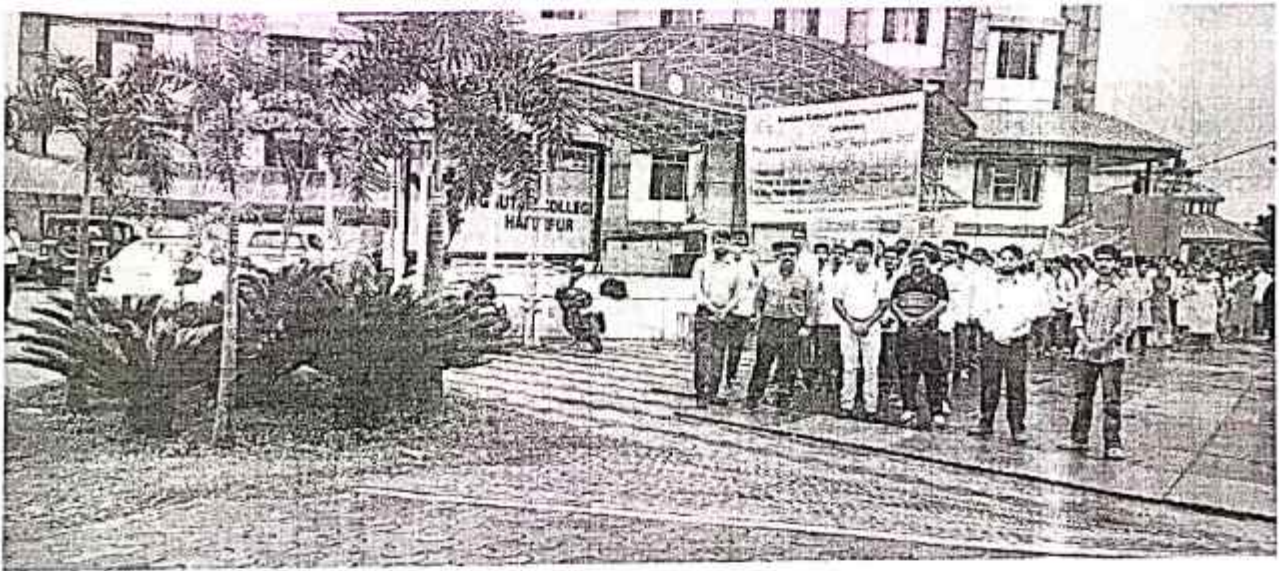

Guest Speakers

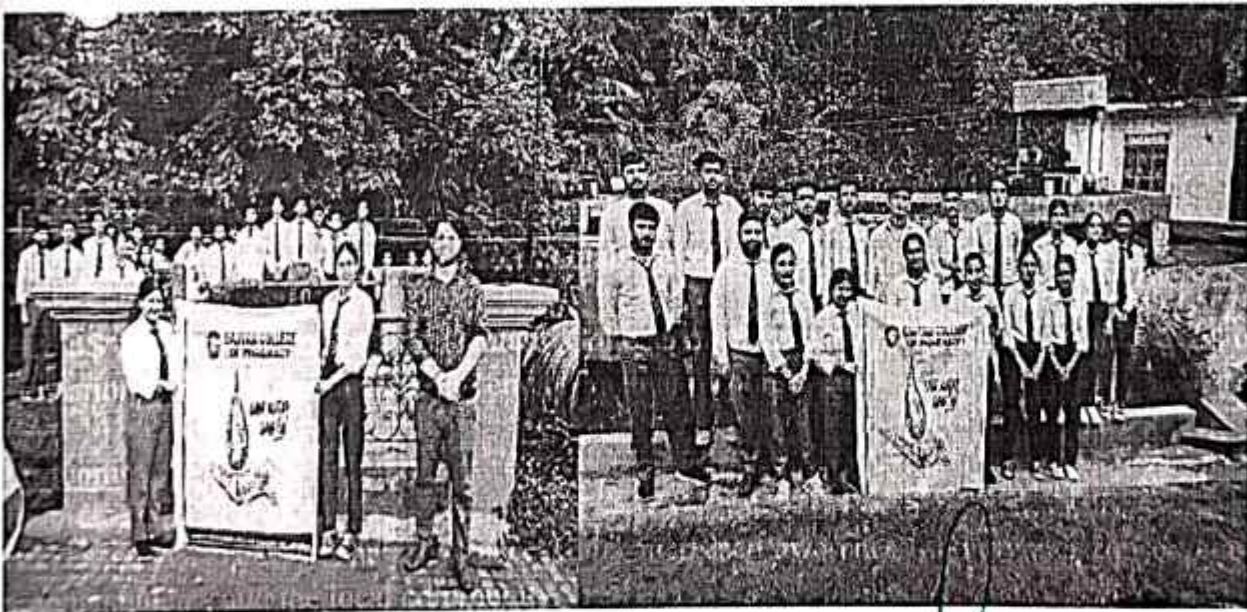
The rally concluded with speeches from notable guests, including:
